### **Pedestrian Struck, Succumbed to Injuries**

Aberdeen, MD – On Wednesday, December 22, 2021, at 6:37 PM, officer's and Emergency Medical Services from Aberdeen Fire Department responded to the 1100 block of S. Philadelphia Blvd. for a motor vehicle crash involving a pedestrian.

When officers arrived on-scene they found 28-year-old James Tyler Blevins of Aberdeen in trauma arrest. Several citizens who come upon the scene stopped and began life saving efforts; however, Mr. Blevins succumbed to his injuries after being transported to a local hospital.

The Aberdeen Police Department requested assistance from the Maryland State Police Crash Team who arrived and began documenting and processing the crash scene.

The vehicle that struck Mr. Blevins did not remain at the scene. Witnesses describe the vehicle as a silver sedan with unknown Pennsylvania registration plates.
