Suspect Arrested in Two Separate Aberdeen Shootings

Aberdeen, MD – The Aberdeen Police Department has arrested Sean Leigh Sconion for two separate shootings that occurred in Aberdeen on March 1, 2022, and March 4, 2022.

On March 1st, 2022, at approximately 2:00 am, the Aberdeen Police Department received a call from the Havre de Grace Police Department in reference to a gunshot wound victim located at Harford Memorial Hospital (HMH).

Upon arrival to the hospital, officers met a 25-year-old male suffering from a graze wound to the chest and gunshot wound to the hand. Detectives arrived on the scene and assumed control of the investigation. Detectives determined the shooting took place in the 100 block of Hanover Street.

On March 4th, 2022, at approximately 10:59 pm, Officers were dispatched to the 700 block of Old Philadelphia Road in reference to a gunshot wound victim. Officers identified a 40-year-old male victim suffering from two gunshot wounds to the abdomen. Medics responded to the scene and transported the victim to Bayview Hospital for treatment. Detectives arrived on the scene and assumed control of the investigation.

Over the days that followed, detectives worked tirelessly to identify a suspect in both shootings. Investigators were able to determine that Sean Leigh Sconion, 31 years-of-age, was responsible for both shootings. At this time, detectives do not believe the shootings to be related.

On Saturday, March 12 an arrest warrant was served on Sconion in the 7000 block of Bel Air Rd, Nottingham, MD. Sconion was taken into custody without incident and charged with two counts of Attempted 1st Degree Murder along with numerous other charges. Sconion is being held without bond at the Harford County Detention Center.
