Quick Arrest Made Following Brannan Road Burglary; Police Seeking Information on Additional Reports

On Monday, March 2, 2026, officers responded to the unit block of Brannan Road for a reported burglary that had just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers cleared the residence and began an investigation. The homeowner arrived shortly thereafter and provided surveillance footage showing a male wearing a red hoodie with a tan coat over it, black pants, a red bookbag, and a blue backpack approach the residence. The video shows the individual opening the door, briefly entering the home, and then exiting after a dog inside began barking.

A review of the footage led to the identification of a suspect, and a coordinated search of the area was conducted. Officers located the suspect and identified him as Courtney Lamont McCoy, 60, of Aberdeen. He was arrested without incident and has been charged with Burglary in the Fourth Degree.

The Aberdeen Police Department is aware of social media posts suggesting there may have been other attempted burglaries in the area. At this time, we encourage any residents who believe they may have been the victim of a burglary or attempted burglary to contact the Police Department so the incidents can be properly documented and investigated.
