Pedestrian Hit While Crossing Short Lane Has Died

Aberdeen, MD – The Aberdeen Police Department is investigating a pedestrian fatality involving a motor vehicle.

On Tuesday, December 3, 2024, at 6:37 a.m., officers responded to MD 715 (Short Lane) around Cirelli Ct for a report of a pedestrian strike.

Preliminary investigation revealed Francis Nyeswah, 72, of Pikesville, MD, was walking in the travel portion of MD 715 when he was struck by a 2018 Chevy Traverse operated by Kenneth Scott-Kosh of Edgewood, MD. Scott-Kosh was the vehicle's sole occupant and remained on the scene until emergency services and police arrived.

No charges have been filed at this time. The cause of the crash is under thorough investigation, and the Harford County Sheriff's Office Crash Team will lead the investigation, ensuring a comprehensive and detailed process.
