Aberdeen, MD – On July 30, 2022, Detectives identified and charged Anthony Jai Wilson, 19, of Havre De Grace with Attempted 1st Degree Murder and other criminal charges related to the shooting of a man in the unit block of Aberdeen Avenue on July 28. Wilson has been transported to the Harford County Detention Center where he is currently being held without bond. The Aberdeen Police Department would like to thank the Bel Air Police Department's Criminal Investigations Unit and the analyst from the Maryland Criminal Intelligence Network Initiative assigned to the Harford County State's Attorney's Office for their assistance in helping bring this case to a close.

Male Found Shot

Aberdeen, MD – On July 28, 2022, at approximately 2:43 AM, officers responded to a medical call for a male lying on the road in the unit block of Aberdeen Ave. Officers arrived and located a subject who was suffering from a gunshot wound. Paramedics were summonsed and began advanced life-saving care. The victim was flown to an area trauma center where he is currently in serious but stable condition.

Criminal Investigators responded to the scene and assumed the investigation. The investigation is ongoing.
